RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH A CAPITAL RESERVE FUND FOR EQUIPMENT TO HARVEST AQUATIC PLANTS

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Fort Ann has received the request from the concerned citizens in the Lake Hadlock Park District relative to the future need to purchase equipment for the harvesting of aquatic plants on Lake Hadlock; and

WHEREAS, the Town currently operates a mechanical harvester on Lake Hadlock to control aquatic plant growth, including the spread of Eurasian Water Milfoil (EWM); and

WHEREAS, the current mechanical harvester being operated on Lake Hadlock is nearing the end of its useful life and the Town Board, on behalf of the Lake Hadlock Park District, is desirous to establish a capital reserve account to budget for, and ultimately fund, the acquisition of the requisite equipment to harvest aquatic plants on Lake Hadlock.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that pursuant to section 6-c of the NY General Municipal Law, as amended, the Town Board of the Town of Fort Ann does hereby establish a Capital Reserve Fund for the Lake Hadlock Park District to finance the cost of acquisition for equipment to harvest aquatic plants on Lake Hadlock; and be it further

RESOLVED, the Supervisor is hereby directed to deposit moneys of this reserve fund in a separate bank account to be known as the Hadlock Park District Aquatic Harvester Reserve Fund; and be it further

RESOLVED, the Supervisor is authorized to invest, from time to time, the moneys of this fund pursuant to General Municipal Law § 6-f; and be it further

RESOLVED, no expenditure shall be made from this fund, except upon authorization of the Town Board pursuant to General Municipal Law § 6-c; and be it further

RESOLVED, pursuant to General Municipal Law section 6-c(4), this resolution is subject to permissive referendum and shall not take effect until thirty (30) days from the date hereof pursuant to Town Law section 91; and be it further

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Fort Ann has received the request from the Lake Hadlock Association and concerned citizens in the Lake Hadlock Park District relative to the continued presence and growth of invasive plants including Eurasian Water Milfoil (EWM); and

WHEREAS, a key component to the combating in spread of invasive plants and managing the existing EWM is to regularly perform an aquatic plant survey on Lake Hadlock; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board is desirous of performing an aquatic plant survey on Lake Hadlock this year, and every three (3) years thereafter.
