It would involve one truck, one day per week, to bring in the water from County Route 16. Once bottled, an 18 wheeler would take it out for delivery. Initially, there would be two bottling machines and the operation would be run by two brothers. Eventually, it may involve, at the most, 3-4 workers. Mr. Mattison asked if the Dept. of Health is involved. Mr. O'Brien stated that an engineer is currently getting specs ready to report to DOH.
