



The first stages of the resoration process include fencing, probing and restoration of headstones. Final stages will be the setting of a flagpole and creation of a commemorative brick landscape base.

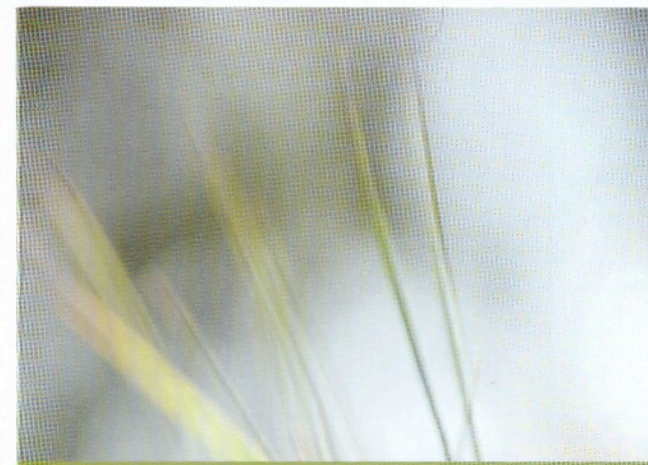

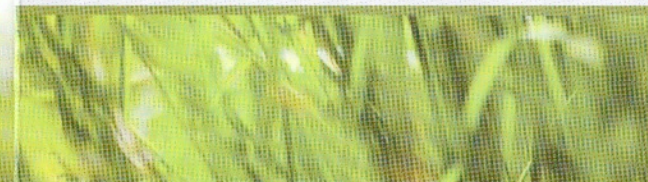
