I want to keep you in the loop of our 1st positive rabies for 2019. On March 13, 2019 a dog (pet) had an encounter with raccoon. The raccoon was killed by pet owners. Initially it was thought the dog was not up to date with its rabies vaccine so raccoon was sent for testing. There was no human exposure. The raccoon came back positive for rabies.

As of today, it was determined the pet was actively immunized at the time of incident and received a booster on 3/13/19.
