RESOLUTION OF COMMITMENT TO PARTICIPATE IN TOWN-WIDE REASSESSMENT

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Fort Ann is desirous of completing a town-wide reassessment to ensure that real property is assessed equitably and uniformly across the whole Town; and

WHEREAS, the current equalization rate for the Town of Fort Ann is at 75%, meaning New York State has determined that the Town's level of assessment is less than the market value of the property within the Town; and

WHEREAS, a town wide reassessment would be completed as a one-time reassessment of all real property tax parcels within the Town to achieve a uniform assessment value of one hundred percent; and

WHEREAS, the State of New York offers different financial incentives and grant opportunities to municipalities that are committed to participating in town-wide reassessment and maintaining an equalization rate of 100%.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED, the Town Board of the Town of Fort Ann hereby agrees to commit to participate in a town-wide reassessment project; and be it further

RESOLVED, the Supervisor is hereby authorized to execute any and all applications and agreements with the State of New York for reimbursement or grants to defer the cost of said town-wide reassessments; and be it further

WHEREAS, The Town of Fort Ann and Washington County developed a shared services plan pursuant to General Municipal Law section 1537, whereby Washington County provided assessment services for the Town of Fort Ann; and

WHEREAS, the parties agreed to terminate the shared services agreement effective December 31, 2023, thereby creating a vacancy in the position of sole assessor for the Town of Fort Ann; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Real Property Tax Law section 310, the Town of Fort Ann must appoint an assessor to serve the balance of the six-year term, which commenced on October 1, 2023; and

WHEREAS, by virtue of the shared services agreement Arek Gordon has been serving in the role of assessor for the Town of Fort Ann and is familiar with the Town and the properties located therein and is committed to retaining the existing office hours.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT

RESOLVED, the Town Board of the Town of Fort Ann hereby hires Arek Gordon as the Sole Assessor effective January 1, 2024 to serve until September 30, 2029, the expiration of his term; and be it further
